## 73rd ANNUAL SASKATCHEWAN CHRISTMAS BIRD COUNT - 2014

The Counts. Every year we gain and lose a varying number of counts with the result that the number conducted since 1995 has fluctuated between a high of 106 in 2001 to a low of 84 in 2009. The death of Wayne Harris in the fall of 2002 was a severe blow to the Saskatchewan CBC as he had participated in no less than 12 counts the previous winter!

This past winter we lost MacDowall naturalist, Myron Barton who was compiler of counts at MacDowall and Wingard-Carlton. Myron passed away on December 30, the very day that he and the senior author would have normally conducted one of the two counts. In spite of this great loss, 10 new or "revived" counts brought the number of counts to 88 from last year's 85.

The Weather. Average minimum and maximum count temperatures this past count period (with 2013-14 records in brackets) were -16 to -12C (-21 to -14C), wind speeds 7 to 15 km/h (10 to 23 km/h), and snow depths 9 to 21 cm (18 to 34 cm).

All three of these weather parameters (warmer, calmer and less snow) would seem more favourable to greater observer effort, and yet the opposite was true as effort was only 1119 hours compared to last year's 1546. Virtually the same number observers participated (721 versus 736), but it appears they preferred to stay home watching feeders setting a record for the proportion of overall effort spent at feeders at 45%.

We are at a loss for a complete explanation, but we know that the threat of freezing rain caused the cancellation of the Coronach Count. Rain was reported on Weyburn Count - perhaps the first such report in the history of the CBC.

The Birds. The absence of the Coronach Count (which contributes an average of 15,000 birds, mostly waterfowl) resulted in a total of only 84,701 birds, the lowest since 1996. The average number of species per count at 17.2 was slightly below the 30 year average of 17.5, while the overall number of species (87 on count day plus

4 count period species) was the lowest since 1992 (77 plus 7). Again, a count of Coronach would probably have boosted the latter number.

Saskatoon led all counts with 43 species on count day plus 2 more during the count period. The city has held the crown for thirteen consecutive years; the runner up, as usual, was Gardiner Dam with 41 species.

Population Trends. There were few trends of note in the numbers of individual species over previous years (Table 7). Some of these include the continued low numbers of upland game birds except the Ruffed Grouse, and the invasion of Northern Goshawk into the Parklands.

The expansion of the Eurasian Collared-Dove seems to have stalled; for the first time since the first CBC records in 1999 no new localities were added. Numbers of most of the finches including Pine Grosbeak, White-winged Crossbill, the redpolls, and Pine Siskin recovered from last year's crash but not enough to return to levels of the last five years.

New Species: A Golden-crowned Sparrow during the count period at Broadview was the first of its kind for the provincial CBC. A firstwinter bird, it was initially seen (and photographed) on November 16 by Don Weidl and intermittently until Dec 27, when it was seen by Doug Boivin. The CBC list now stands at an amazing 187 species.

Other Rarities. The only other rarity of note was the provincial CBC's third and Saskatoon's second Cassin's Finch.

For the second consecutive winter, a female-plumaged bird appeared at Phil Taylor's feeder, it was recorded during count periods Jan 2 and 4.
