

## NOTICE OF 1988 ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING AND PROPOSED REVISIONS TO THE SNHS CONSTITUTION

The following revisions to the SNHS constitution are proposed for approval by the membership at the 1988 Annual Meeting of the Society to be held in Saskatoon 14-16 October 1988. Please refer to the 1987 September issue of the *Blue Jay News* for a copy of the full constitution.

1.) *Resolved* that the Objects of the Society adopted at the 1968 annual meeting be amended by deleting current point 2:

“To stimulate, develop and maintain the interest of the general public and individuals, firms and corporations in the conservation of our natural resources.”

and adding new points 2 and 3 as follows with subsequent points renumbered accordingly:

“2. To work for wise use of Saskatchewan’s natural heritage ensuring sur-

vival of all native species and representative natural areas and maintenance of healthy and diverse wildlife populations throughout the province.

3. To stimulate and conduct research which will increase knowledge of all aspects of the natural world.”

2.) *Resolved* that Article XI of the Constitution of the Society adopted at the 1968 annual meeting be amended by replacing “Subject to Section 47 of The Societies Act, 1959” with “Subject to Section 199 of the Non-Profit Corporations Act.”

3.) *Resolved* that Article VIII of the Constitution of the Society adopted at the 1968 annual meeting be amended to read: “The fiscal year of the Society shall terminate on 31 August of each year.”
